F-M Sertoma Club's American Flag Displays in Lindenwood Park and at Trollwood Performing Arts Center

For nearly 50 years the Fargo Moorhead Sertoma Club has provided an important patriotic service by arranging for the display of the American flag throughout the community. Most recently we provide flag displays at both Lindenwood Park (1905 Roger Maris Drive South in Fargo and Trollwood Performing Arts Center, 801 50th Ave S, Moorhead. These proud, colorful and attractive displays are expressions of our community's love and respect for our flag and country and are much appreciated by the community.

Past community support has provided funds for the purchase, care and placement of the flags on designated celebrated holidays and days of recognition for our brave veterans. There are seven days a year that the flags will be displayed in Lindenwood Park; Armed Forces Day, Memorial Day, Flag Day, Emancipation Day, Independence Day, Labor Day and September 11th. Flags are displayed at Trollwood/Blue Stem during their annual summer main stage performances, the Andrew Nelson Memorial Cross County Meet and when a major event is held on a date near a national holiday.
